About 200 Days To Go:

Gilmary Council 3868 was established <u>January 28, 1952.</u> Next <u>January 28, 2022,</u> we will celebrate our <u>70th Anniversary</u>. *Be with us and Celebrate!*



Within the decoration on the top of our Constitution is the Latin phrase "Esto Dignus" which translates to "Be Worthy!"

The 30 Names are our worthy Founders.

Origin of Our Council's Name "Gilmary!":

In the Irish-Gaelic Language, there are two certain words: one is "Giolla" meaning "follower/servant."; and the second word is the Proper name and spelling for Mary - The Blessed Virgin. That name is "Mhuire" and is the <u>very exclusive spelling</u> used <u>only</u> for the Blessed Virgin (the common spelling for the name Mary is "Máire.") Both are pronounced MAH-ree. In the Gaelic it is: *Mac Giolla Mhuire*, and meaning "Servant of Mary." = Siolla Mhuire.

When the two names came into the USA and met up and combined with the American accent and spelling and syllabizing, it became "Gilmary!", and developed on to become the American surname of "Gilmore," of which there are 64,000 Americans!



The Holy Archangel Michael is one of the most celebrated of the Angels and bodiless powers; he is called the *Archistrategos*, *or Chief Commander*, of all the bodiless powers. According to Holy Scripture and Tradition, he has interceded for humanity multiple times and continues to serve as the Defender of the Faith. Michael is most often invoked for protection from invasion by enemies plus from civil war, and for the defeat of adversaries on the field of battle.

He is celebrated on **November 8** — the Synaxis of Michael and all the Bodiless Powers of Heaven.

The name Michael means "Like unto God," or, "Who is like unto God?"

<u>Saint Michael the Archangel</u>, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil.

May God rebuke him we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls.
